The scale of pay is Rs.14000/- to Rs. 49000/-plus Grade Pay of Rs. 8,700- PM with other allowances as admissible. The appointments shall be made purely on contractual basis initially for a period of 11 months subject to renewal of the contract depending on the satisfactory performance. - 2. B.Ed. degree from any recognized University (**PARANGAT** to be treated as B.Ed. degree only for the purpose of Hindi teaching).
- 3. In pursuance of the Govt. OM No. ASE.238/2014/213, dtd. 22.11.2019, those institutions having territorial jurisdiction outside the State of Assam but having a study centre in the State and such study centres if not recognized by DEC under UGC, the degrees / certificates issued by such off campus institutions shall not be considered as valid for the purpose of employment under Education Department.  - (i) As Adarsha Vidyalayas are CBSE affiliated English medium secondary school the candidates must have passed class 12th or equivalent Examination with English Language as one of the subjects or read from Class IX onwards in English Medium School..
 - (ii) Provided that for recruitment of teacher for teaching MIL subject, the candidate who passed HSLC examination with particular MIL subject shall be considered.
 - (iii) A candidate must be not more than 45 years of age as on 1st January, 2023.

(a) Criteria for Selection of Graduate Teacher (Arts and Science):

- **I.** 100 marks on percentage of marks in B.A/B.Com/B.Sc examination (in case of Major/Hons, the marks obtained in Major/Hons shall be taken into consideration).
- **II.** 100 marks on percentage of marks in Higher Secondary final examination.
- **III.** 100 marks on percentage of marks in B.Ed .final examination.
- **IV.** 100 marks on percentage of marks in TET examination.
- V. Explanation: For the purpose of calculation of marks under the categories mentioned in clauses (i)(ii), (iii) and (iv) above it may be clarified that if a candidate secures; for

example 60% marks in the particular examination he/she secure 60 marks out of 100 marks allotted in the concerned examination.

(b) Criteria for Selection (1) Graduate Teacher (Hindi):

- **I.** 100 marks on percentage of marks in BA Examination with the concerning language as one of the subjects or highest degree in the language i.e. Pravin / Ratna Examination in case of Hindi Teacher.
- **II.** 100 marks on percentage of marks in HS final examination.
- **III.** 100 marks on percentage of marks in B.Ed. final examination.
- **IV.** 100 marks on percentage of marks in TET examination
- N.B. In all the above mentioned category of teachers, any other marks obtained in any other examinations such as HSLC or equivalent, Post Graduation and any other professional qualification not mentioned in the NCTE guidelines the decision of Adarsha Vidyalaya will be final.

> Other Criteria

- 1. District-wise, , Subject-wise separate Merit Listswill be prepared for each category of the post.
- 2. A candidate must not be less than 18 years of age and not more than 45 years as on 1st January, 2023
- 3. The eligible candidates shall apply online in the official website of DTE, Assam, i.e. www.dte.assam.gov.infrom 12:00 AM of 3rd February-2023 to 12:00 AM of 12th February-2023
- 4. No offline application will be accepted in this regard.
- 5. The Online Applications and documents submitted by the candidates will be verified along with their original testimonials, by the Adarsha Vidyalaya Sangathan, Assam (AVSA). The District-wise detailed schedule and venue for Screening/ Verification of documents will be notified in the official website. No TA/DA is admissible for verification process. District wise verification will be conducted centrally by Adarsha Vidyalaya Sangathan. Candidates will be informed collectively in the official website by the competent authority of Adarsha Vidyalaya Sangathan.
- 6. The Online Application and documents submitted by the candidate will be verified using modern technology with the help of DigiLocker, Govt. of India and by scanning Barcode or QR Code for ensuring genuineness of the uploaded documents as well as by back office verification with the competent board/council/ authority. But the authority if desires may conduct physical document verification at any point of time with proper notice.
- 7. The candidate must ensure genuineness of all the information/ documents uploaded against the online application and he/ she will be solely responsible for the information/ documents uploaded against his/ her online application. Once uploaded there will be no scope of correction in respect of the credential submitted by the candidate. Any discrepancy will lead to cancellation of the candidature.
- 8. The candidature will be cancelled forthwith, if any kind of fraudulence/ discrepancy regarding any information / documents uploaded by the candidate is established by appropriate authority at any point of time. The candidate will be debarred from any future recruitment under Government of Assam and subsequent legal action will also be initiated against such candidate.
- 9. A candidate will mention and select the name of the districts for which the application is submitted.
- 10. When the candidates appear for the verification before the Adarsha Vidyalaya Sangathan they must produce original certificates, testimonials and documents that was uploaded during the application stage.
- 11. Reservation is not applicable, selection will be purely on merit basis.
- 12. The Madrassa TET and CTET shall not be considerd in the the recruitment process of Graduate Teacher ARTS / SCIENCE and HINDI
